

a first priority, but at the same time we are getting back into all of the other kinds of things that Customs historically had done and in my judgment and in the opinion of my associates should have been doing right along.

I think if you look over, just for example, our narcotic and dangerous drug seizures, we made 2,794 seizures in August. In the first 9 months of 1973 we made over 18,000 narcotic and dangerous drug seizures. This is more than we made in the whole of last year. So our people's enthusiasm, motivation, dedication as Customs Officers, has not waned, not slackened off a bit.

I think, too, the billion dollar Customs duty yield just in the first 3 months of this fiscal year is also another factor indicative of a lot of thought and hard work that our people are engaged in.

#### TRANSFERS UNDER REORGANIZATION PLAN AND NEW DUTIES

Mr. STEED. Could you provide for the record a rather detailed list of all the stuff that you had, people and supplies and materials and everything, that was transferred pursuant to Reorganization Plan No. 2?

Mr. ACREE. Yes, sir, be pleased to do that.

Mr. STEED. Then could you put right under that another little summary on the plus side of the additional duties and workload, the demands, that are being made upon you simultaneously with this placing or giving of your resources?

Mr. ACREE. Yes, sir.

Mr. STEED. I think we would like to have them right together.

Mr. ACREE. A balance sheet, yes, sir.
